Resolution – Exams as Useful Academic Tools

Whereas, The Student Code of Conduct (SCC) and the Policy on the Integrity of Scholarship forbid the use of unauthorized aids and previously administered exams may be considered unauthorized aids,

Whereas, The Academic Success Program and various campus organizations maintain test banks regardless of whether or not the tests are considered authorized aids,

Whereas, Previously administered questions allows students to test their knowledge and identify any areas where their understanding and knowledge of the topics covered may be weak.

Whereas, Access to previously administered questions also allows for students to focus their studies on scenarios and examples from throughout a course to illustrate key points and aid understanding.

Whereas, A centralized test bank would increase access and affordability to education by expanding the number of academic resources available to students for free, therefore be it,

Resolved, The Associated Students (ASUCSD) finds the use of previously administered tests a useful academic tool and the access to these authorized exams should be centralized under the authority of one entity.
